

Small Paws Bed and Biscuit 2011 Visiting Information

Your dog must be up to date on their shots including Distemper, Rabies and Bordetella (kennel cough). You can either bring shot records at drop off or have your animal clinic fax to 622-9646.

It is suggested you bring your dog's food, so both their environment and food are not changed at the same time. However, it is not required.

You are welcome to bring your dog's bed and toys; whatever makes them feel comfortable at their time of visit. However, Small Paws does provide toys, beds, bowls and treats.

Please indicate whether your dog is allowed to have treats and bones while visiting. Some dogs have allergies to certain products.

Please indicate whether your dog is on any type of medication or needs special care.

If vet bills incur due to normal health problems or accidental injury, reimbursement will be at time of pick up.

Appointments to pick up and drop off are required.

If you cancel your vacation or travel plans, please call and cancel your reservation with Small Paws. If not canceled within 24 hours prior to reservation a \$10 fee will be incurred and will need to be paid at the time of next visit.

If you know you will be running more than 15 minutes late on drop off or pick up, call to confirm what time you will be arriving.
